


PLAT OF INDIAN HILLS EXTENDED, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA

PLAT OF INDIAN HILLS EXTENDED, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, ALLEN COUNTY, INDIANA

Indian Village, Inc. and J. C. Thompson Tool & Die, Inc., both Indiana corporations, by and through their respective duly authorized officers, being the owners of the following described real estate:

That part of the West Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 33 North, Range 12 East, in Allen County, Indiana, lying east of the right-of-way of the Lake Erie & Western Railroad formerly known as Fort Wayne, Muncie & Cincinnati Railroad, and south of the right-of-way of the Wabash Railroad, formerly the Lake Erie, Wabash and St. Louis Railroad, north of the centerline of the public highway known as the Eagle Road and west of and adjacent to the west boundary of Indian Hills Addition, a plat of which is recorded in Plat Record 20, pages 19-20, in the Office of the Recorder of Allen County, Indiana, and also west of the west boundary of Indian Village Addition, Section 8, the plat of which is recorded in Plat Record 20, pages 27-29, in the Office of the Recorder of Allen County, Indiana,

hereby cause said real estate to be platted into lots, blocks, streets, alleys, and easements in accordance with the plan and plat attached hereto, to be known as INDIAN HILLS EXTENDED, an Addition to the City of Fort Wayne, Allen County, Indiana.

The lots in said Addition are numbered and designated as Lots Two Hundred Sixty-one (261) to Two Hundred Eight (268) consecutively and Blocks "G", "H", "I", "J", "K", "L", "M", "N", "O", "P", "Q", "R", "S", "T", "U", "V", "W", "X", "Y", "Z", and streets, alleys, and easements on the face of the plat. All lots and blocks are subject to the provisions of building setback lines and easements as indicated on the face of the plat and as hereinafter more specifically set forth.

Easements are hereby expressly reserved and delineated in and over the east seven (7) feet of Lot numbered 261 to 269 consecutively and inclusive, the east seven (7) feet of Blocks "J", "K", and "L", the south seven (7) feet of Lots Numbered 261 and 262, the north seven (7) feet of Block "M", and the north fourteen (14) feet of Block "O" and 120 feet east of and parallel to the front lot lines of Lots Numbered 270 to 285 consecutively and inclusive, for the erection, construction, and maintenance of poles, wires, and conduits and the necessary or proper attachments in connection therewith for the transmission of electricity and for telephone and other purposes; also for the construction and maintenance of drains, sewers, pipe lines for supplying gas, water or heat, and for any other public or quasi-public utility or function maintained, furnished, or performed by or in any school beneath the surface of the ground and any municipal, public or quasi-public corporation engaged in supplying any one or more of the above utilities will have the right to enter upon said easements for any purpose for which said easements are reserved as aforesaid.

The undersigned owners hereby declare and provide that Lots Numbered 270 and 280, and Blocks "G" and "H", shall each be subject to certain restrictions, rights-of-way, licenses, restrictions, and easements reserved in, upon, and over said lots and blocks to Indiana and Michigan Electric Company in a certain deed of conveyance executed by said Indiana and Michigan Electric Company to the undersigned, Indian Village, Inc., on May 31, 1955, which deed was recorded June 4, 1955 in Book Record 229, page 424-425, in the Records of Allen County, Indiana.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, Indian Village, Inc., owner of all of the aforesaid part of land, excepting only Block "G", to-

gether with the undersigned, J. C. Thompson Tool & Die, Inc., owner of said Block "G", have caused the signatures of their respective duly authorized officers and their respective corporate seals to be affixed to this plat, this 17th day of September, 1956.
