Notaries have been going door to door on the weekends collecting signatures. If you have not signed the Covenants and would like for a notary to come by your home so you can sign, please call Sarah Didier at 747-7141, and she will make the arrangements. The ONLY way Indian Village can become a unified neighborhood once again, is to get these Covenants signed and recorded with the Allen County Recorder's Office.

2016 Associate Membership

The 2016 Application for Associate Membership is open to all residents living OUTSIDE of Sections C & D. The Application can be downloaded from IVCA's website at www.indianvillagefw.com. There is a link on the Home Page for the Application. If you want to have a vote at the March Meeting, you must live in Sections C & D, OR be an Associate Member. The membership is annual, so if you filled out an application last year, you must do so again this year.

Quarterly Smoke Signals

With IVCA running on very limited funds, the Smoke Signals is one of those items getting cut.
